

RESIDENTIAL WAIVER-RECREATIONAL

In situations in which a player meets the requirements to move to another Association under the "NO RECREATIONAL TEAM" in a Division as a result of his/her Residential Association offering no RECREATIONAL team in the player's age division, the player may apply for a Residential Waiver-Recreation transfer for participation at the indicated adjacent Association. The Residential Waiver-Recreational transfer does not become effective until the form has been completed and filed with the OMAHA District Registrar. PRIOR TO PARTICIPATION A TRANSFER REQUEST MUST BE INITIATED ON THE HCR.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The player's Home Association shall declare that they will not be having a recreational team in the player's age division for the current season on this form.
- 2. Player must obtain this form from his/her Home Association and present to an adjacent Association.
- 3. New Association is to sign the form indicating acceptance of the player and initiate a Residential Waiver transfer request on the HCR. This form should be attached to the transfer request.
- 4. Participation is permitted at Practices only until such time as the transfer request has been approved by BC Hockey on the HCR. Player MUST be pre-registered with their Home Association in order for this to occur.
